<u>Description</u> - Provide a brief overview of project plan:

As a biology instructor who often teaches introductory biology classes, I often discuss with my students topics related to how humans have affected our environment. One major outcome of our current culture is the vast amount of plastic waste that we are generating. In order to model the value of reducing waste and conserving resources, I would like to purchase reusable whiteboard markers. These dry erase board markers are refillable, and by refilling these markers I could reuse the same ones for years, instead of going through multiple markers in one semester. I have used these types of markers in the past, and they have led to interesting conversations with students about how much "stuff" we use in our everyday lives and where our waste goes when we throw it "away."
