RE: Support for the CED Committee recommendation to dedicate 25% of the "remainder parcel" land sale proceeds to a fund devoted to maintenance of Measure DD improvements around Lake Merritt.

Dear Council Member Kaplan:

Waterfront Action is an Oakland-based volunteer non-profit whose mission is to promote public access to the Oakland-Alameda Estuary and Lake Merritt through using public awareness, education, and direct action. Our members place high value on the region's waterfront as a vibrant economic, recreational, and natural resource.

I am writing to urge the Council to approve the DDA for the "remainder parcel" under terms consistent with the April 14, 2015 recommendation of the Council's CED Committee dedicating 25% of the "remainder parcel" land sale proceeds to a fund devoted to maintenance of Measure DD improvements around Lake Merritt.

Measure DD has created the most significant and broadly-recognized advances in Oakland's waterfront in decades. Nevertheless, as a bond it is unable to fund the maintenance and protection of these widely-praise new facilities, which will soon fall into shameful disrepair without special action. The "remainder parcel" is a product of Measure DD plans, construction, and road realignment. Accordingly, one appropriate special action is exactly that recommended by CED Committee.
