Waterfront Action is writing in support of the City of Oakland's application for a \$100,000 Proposition 84 grant to help fund a bridge connection feasibility study for the Oakland Measure DD Lake Merritt Channel project area. The grant will permit the City to prepare the necessary preliminary plans concerning bridge location, structure, and costs, as well as initial CEQA and NEPA work.

Waterfront Action is an Oakland non-profit whose mission is to promote public access to the Oakland-Alameda Estuary and Lake Merritt.
