4. Measure DD Project Update – Lesley Estes

Measure DD Project Status Summary Spreadsheet

Lesley prepared and distributed a March 12, 2015 revision of this document, which now focuses on projects that are active or upcoming. This document has been posted to the Coalition's web page in the <u>City of Oakland Resources section</u>.

Lesley very briefly highlighted the status of the following ongoing or upcoming projects as described on the <u>Project Status Summary</u> spreadsheet:

- Sailboat House will finish and reopen by June 1st
- Sausal Creek Restoration –construction to start this summer
- Bellevue Avenue Reconfiguration will go out to bid this summer
- Grand Avenue Entry will go out to bid this summer
- Lakeside Green Street Project –environmental documentation complete, should go out to bid end of this year

<u>10th Street Bridge Update</u>

The AT&T and other utility relocation issues, which have delayed the project, are now expected to be resolved in about 6 months. Lesley provided before and after photographs of the concrete pour.

<u>BAY TRAIL UPDATES</u>: all items were moved to the July Agenda Lesley announced that the Harbor Master and marina owner will be meeting with her to discuss access to the Bay Trail. ConAgra/Cemex/Outboard Motors

Dianne Tannenwald is working with new management with the approach that with permission the City (DD) can do the trail. Later the business will have to do the trail at their cost.
