

Historic East 18th Street Pier

Description

Reconstructed the concrete pile foundations and restored pier's architectural elements.

Elements/Goals

- Re-opened this City of Oakland and National Historic Landmark structure, originally built circa 1916
- Reconstructed concrete pile foundations to address structural deficiencies
- Salvaged and restored pier's architectural rails and columns Replicated and reinstalled ornate light standards

Budget & Funding

\$1,900,000 total project costs, including:

- \$1,600,000 Measure DD
- \$300,000 Proposition 12 State Grant




